Day One - Thursday - April 23, 2015

Day Four - Sunday - April 26, 2015 L - D

Closed to the public for nearly a year while undergoing a multi-million dollar renovation, NBC Studios is reopening their Behind the Scenes tour in 2015. Visit broadcast sets, learn production secrets maybe even deliver your own news cast when we visit 30 Rockefeller Plaza. Then catapult up 70 floors in less than a minute on the Sky Shuttle to "Top of the Rock". Here you can soak up amazing, unobstructed 360° views: from the sweeping green of Central Park to the soaring skyscrapers of the Financial District. Celebrate midday with Sunday Brunch at the Trump Grill, located in the iconic Trump Tower on Fifth Avenue.

We'll indulge in Eggs Benedict, Steak and Eggs, and even a Bloody Mary! Just steps away from Trump Tower is the "Showplace of the Nation", Radio City Music Hall. And Good Neighbors Club travelers are invited back stage to discover the secrets and splendor of this amazing building.
