

Day 1: San Antonio, TX - Tour Begins

It's easy to see why San Antonio is often referred to as the "American Venice." Historic missions, River Walk restaurants, Spanish architecture and a beautiful river centerpiece make this a truly remarkable city. This evening get to know your fellow travelers at a welcome reception.

Day 2: San Antonio

Your day begins with a fascinating tour of San Antonio with a local guide. History and culture abound with a visit to two UNESCO World Heritage sites. Visit the Mission San Jose, the second mission established by Fray Antonio Margil de Jesus in 1720. This is followed by a visit to the Alamo, which played a critical role in the Texas Revolution. People worldwide continue to remember the Alamo as a heroic struggle against impossible odds - a place where men made the ultimate sacrifice for freedom. Next, browse for one-of-a-kind goods at El Mercado, the Mexican Marketplace. This afternoon the choice is yours: you may choose to visit the South Texas Heritage Center, an interactive museum dedicated to sharing the stories of San Antonio's people and the land that has shaped their lives; or, perhaps you would prefer to explore the 33-acre grounds of the San Antonio Botanical Gardens featuring expansive rose gardens, a conservatory with tropical vegetation, and the Texas Native Trail showcasing ecosystems from the diverse regions of the state. This evening, discover the rich history of San Antonio's newly renovated Pearl District, once the site of the Pearl Brewery, founded in 1881. Led by a local guide, the walking tour will include points of historic, cultural and architectural interest as you explore this mixed-use area of new and carefully restored buildings that now house restaurants, boutiques, living spaces and hotels. Dinner is included at a

restaurant located in this unique and lively riverside neighborhood. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 3: San Antonio - Stonewall - Fredericksburg - San Antonio Rodeo Journey to Stonewall and enjoy a visit to the LBJ Ranch, birthplace of the 36th President of the United States, Lyndon B. Johnson. On your tour of the ranch you will view the "Texas White House" and learn about living in the Texas Hill Country. Continue to the heart of the rural Hill Country and the German settlement of Fredericksburg. The old-time southwest will surround you as you take time to independently explore the quaint shops. This evening you are in for a special treat when you watch some of the country's top cowboys compete at the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, followed by a live music concert. *Today breakfast will be included.*


Day 4: San Antonio

Enjoy some leisure time this morning to explore San Antonio on your own. Then, visit a picturesque olive orchard.* Enjoy a tour of the orchard complete with a wine and olive oil tasting and learn about its history before indulging in a spectacular Texas-inspired farewell lunch. This evening, board a boat and drift along the Paseo del Rio, also known as the River Walk, one of Texas's most prized attractions.
